Are you unable to leave your home to get the COVID-19 vaccine? You might be eligible to get the vaccine at your home.

There are many options for individuals with disabilities

If you can travel to a vaccine clinic, there are drive-thru options at Gilroy High School and East Valley Clinic. Make an appointment by calling 211 or online at sccFreeVax.org, then request drive-thru service at the site upon arrival. If you need assistance traveling to a vaccine site, VTA offers door-to-door shuttle service. Call 408-809-2124.

How to determine if you are eligible for in-home vaccine

To receive home-based vaccination under the County of Santa Clara's Program, you must:

- Generally be unable to leave your home because of a medical condition or disability; AND
- When you do leave home, it is considerably taxing and requires assistance.
