### Food Pantry

Two food programs: a three-day supplemental supply of groceries and an assortment of food for homeless customers that requires no prep or cooking. Customers can receive food twice a month (once time between 1st and 14th, and again between 15th and end of month), and may access additional produce once a week. The Pantry is one of only two programs at Sacred Heart that are zip code specific.
